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Kathyrn School Home Reading Approach

Dear Kathyrn Kodiak Families,

We are excited to share our home reading approach with families! We were able to purchase home reading books at the end of last year and now we are beginning our Home Reading Approach on Tuesday, November 1. Students will have a home reading bag with their name on it. Students are asked to return their home reading every Tuesday.

Our home reading approach is designed to support the following:

- Meaningful student engagement
- · Flexibility and choice for busy families
- Rich and enjoyable parental involvement
- Increased student reading ability and confidence

Our home reading approach includes 4 considerations:

- 1. Student Book/Text Selection Selecting from high quality reading materials
 - At school, students are able to select from a specific grade range cart every Tuesday
 - This is in addition to their Learning Common times
- 2. Students are encouraged to ready daily
 - 15 30 minutes per day
- 3. Family Involvement Required
 - Read to and with you child, as well as listen to your child/ren read
 - Talk about what you read together, ask questions and make connections with child/children each time you read
- 4. Enjoy a Variety of Home Reading Participation Choices Have fun mixing it up!
 - Read To Me student(s) listen to a adult reader read, following along with the parent tracking the
 - Read With Me student(s) take turns reading with an adult reader
 - Listen To Me Read student(s) read to an adult (and other children, as desired)
 - **Listen to Reading With Me** listen together to a fluent reader, asking questions and making connections together
